A MOMENT WITH MIKE

During our worship service on March 14th, Dr. Roger Davidson, our Staff-Pastor-Parish Relations Committee (S.P.R.C.) chair, announced that the bishop and appointive cabinet of the lowa Conference of the United Methodist Church have appointed me to serve as pastor of the Cherokee United Methodist Church, effective July 1st of this year. During these past (what will be) four years, I have gotten to know many of you and have enjoyed serving as your pastor. We have had times of celebration and accomplishments in ministry together, and we have certainly had struggles with COVID. I know that as I move to Cherokee and another pastor moves to Harlan, you will continue to be in ministry with one another and the community. We do not yet know who your next pastor will be, but our district superintendent has been in communication with our S.P.R.C. committee as she and the rest of the appointive cabinet make a prayerful decision. Once a decision has been made, Dr. Davidson will make the announcement during a worship service.

I have some additional news to share, as I have been in conversation with our district superintendent and our S.P.R.C. committee about taking a renewal leave. Pastors in full time ministry are encouraged to take a renewal leave every four years in order to rest, reflect, grow spiritually, and recharge for ministry. In my 17 years as pastor (12 of them full-time in the lowa Annual Conference), I have not yet taken a leave. The Bishop, District Superintendent, Cabinet, and Annual Conference Continuing Education Committee have approved a renewal leave for me, which I will be taking April 11th—May 31st. During this time, I will be involved in continuing education opportunities, and I will continue my district and conference responsibilities. While I am on leave, the Rev. Lori Shannon will provide coverage for Sunday services and emergency pastoral situations. In the case of an emergency, Rev. Lori can be reached by calling 712-653-3017. Please be in prayer during this time of transition and change.
